

Canadian Pre-University / Matriculation

The Ontario Secondary School Diploma (Grade 12) from Canada is a recognised qualification for entry into universities in Canada and most universities in USA, Australia, New Zealand and the UK. Private institutions of learning in Malaysia offer the diploma through the following programmes:

- **International Canadian Pre-University (ICPU)**
- **Canadian International Matriculation Programme (CIMP)**

Entry Requirements:

SPM / O level / UEC or equivalent
(5 credits including English, Mathematics or Science)

Duration:

1 year (2 semesters) minimum

Intakes:

January (Main intake), March and July

Examination dates:

May / June (Jan intake) and November / December (July intake)

Tuition Fee :

RM17,000 - RM 25,000. (Fees are higher for students who take science subjects).

Assessment:

A Student's final grade is based on coursework (70%) and a final examination (30%). Coursework is carried out throughout the programme and includes assignments, quizzes, attendance, participation in class and class tests.

Subjects:

Candidates must pass 6 subjects, including English and an official external literacy test (Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test) which is conducted once a year.

A student without the required English Language proficiency may be required to take a pre requisite English Language subject at Grade 11 Level in the first semester.

** Students are also required to dedicate themselves to 10 hours of community service.*
